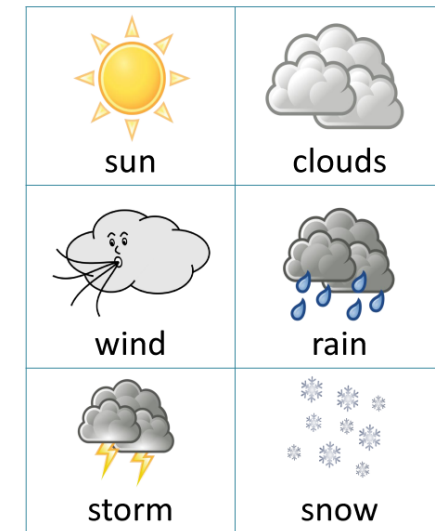
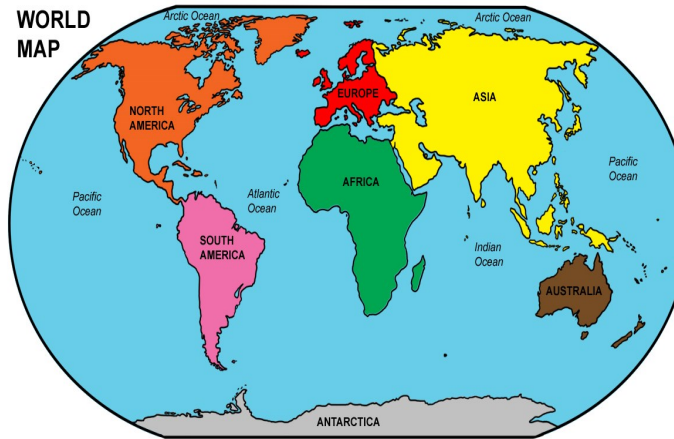

## Information

The North Pole is the point that is farthest north on the planet Earth and the South Pole is located in Antarctica.
