Science Knowledge Organiser Light (Term 4)


Our learning

Sun is a natural source of light. Lights and candles are artificial sources of light.

Information

Light is needed in order to see things. Dark is when there is no light.

Light may come directly from a light source (such as the sun) but can also be reflected from an object into our eyes in order to be seen.

Shadows are made when the light from a light source is **blocked** by an **opaque** object.


Shadows can be different shapes and sizes.

Light that comes from the sun can be dangerous and you should always protect your eyes and skin.
