Henry VIII was the King of England from 1509—1547.

He was **famous** for having had six wives.

Henry wanted a **divorce** from one of his wives and so he changed the rules of the Church and put himself in charge.

Michelham Priory was taken by Henry in 1537 and given to one of his friends.

## Important Dates

**1485**— The Tudor period began

**1509**—Henry VIII became King (until his death in 1547).

**1534**— Henry VIII became head of the Church of England..

**1603**—The Tudor period ends
