OAKWOOD BEHAVIOUR PATHWAY
Ready, Respectful, Safe

- Verbal Reminders**
First, a group reminder of expected behaviours is given. Next, a private, personal reminder is given.
- Choices Offered**
You will be given limited choices to support you in making a change to your behaviour.
- Reset Opportunity**
You will be offered 5 minutes to reset your behaviour. This may take place in the classroom or a shared space, supported by an adult.
- Time to Learn**
You will be asked to complete your learning in a different classroom. (Change of face and space).
- Reflection Room**
You will need to complete your learning and a reflection task in the reflection room. This may be instead of learning in your classroom or during break/lunch time.
- SLT Consequence**
Your behaviour has led to a further consequence which will be decided by SLT. This may be an internal seclusion or school suspension.

In the Summer term, our parent body provided feedback that they would like to see our school continue to raise expectations to enable all children to be successful in the classroom, on a daily basis. You wanted us to better manage poor behaviour from key children, maintain calm and purposeful learning environments and establish equal treatment for everyone. To achieve this, we've renewed our school rules: ready, respectful, safe and have been working alongside our teaching staff to refine our consequence pathway. We're looking to share this more explicitly with parents and children at the start of next half-term.
