Writing in EYFS

At Oakwood we follow the Read Write Inc phonics scheme. Children are taught letter formation and apply this to simple writing tasks. Opportunities are set up for children to practice their writing with small group adult support and independently during continuous provision.



Writing in KS1

As the children move through Key Stage 1, they learn to apply what they have been taught in their phonics lessons to their writing. The children develop their ideas into full sentences and paragraphs. Two week writing units allow the children to plan and develop extended pieces of writing using a model text as guidance.



Writing in KS2

Units are planned in two-week blocks, which allow the children to analyse a model text, plan their own version and then edit and publish their piece at the end. Grammar teaching is built into each unit, along with key vocabulary. A range of genres and purposes for writing are covered.
