## Reading in EYFS

Children are exposed to a wider variety of books and texts, which are often used as a vehicle for their topic-based learning. We promote a love of reading through daily story times and 'talk through stories'. In addition to this, we are proud of supporting children to become 'proficient early readers' through our phonics sessions where they learn to segment and blend sounds and words.



## Reading in KS1

At Oakwood, all children have a 'Daily supported reading' session for 25 minutes. These are small group guided-reading sessions, with adult support. Children move groups regularly according to assessments and progress.



## Reading in KS2

The Destination Reader approach is followed from Years 3-6. Children study a book (or books) in depth each term, whilst developing key reading skills such as prediction, clarification and making connections. Children also take part in the Accelerated Reader programme, which encourages reading for pleasure.
