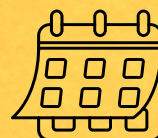

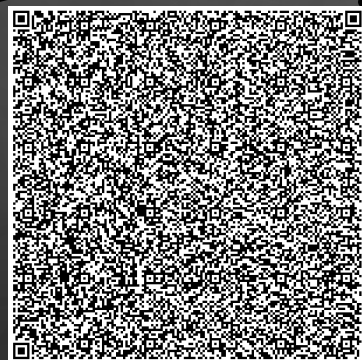
We're pleased to invite parents to attend our Summer concerts this year on Tuesday 14th July.
